4. The First Information Report has been lodged by respondent no. 3, which has been registered as Case Crime No. 110 of 2016, under Section 386 of IPC, at Police Station- Ranipur, District-Haridwar against the petitioner. Apprehending his arrest, the petitioner has approached this Court for relief.
5. The petitioner has demanded extortion from the complainant/respondent no.3. Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent no.3 submits that petitioner has long criminal history of similar offences, a fact which is admitted by the learned counsel for the State.
6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of offence, no interference is being called for by this Court in the matter.
7. In view thereof, the writ petition is hereby dismissed.
