Applicants Vijendra Sah, Gaurav Kumar, Subhash Kumar, Avdhesh Kumar, Pintu Podar and Manohar Kumar seek bail in connection with Case Crime No. 16 of 2016, under Sections 406, 417, 419 and 420 of IPC, Police Station Lohaghat, District Champawat.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and considered the grounds taken up in the bail application.

An FIR was lodged against six unknown cheats alleging therein that they defrauded village women folk by reducing the contents of Gold in their jewellery while returning the same. The applicants are in jail since 13.08.2016 and there is no previous criminal history against them. Learned counsel for the applicants also submitted that the applicants are ready to furnish reliable and verified sureties to the satisfaction of the Magistrate concerned if they are granted bail.

Considering the overall conspectus of things, as also the grounds taken up in the bail application, a case of bail is made out in favour of the applicants.

Bail application is allowed. Let the applicants be enlarged on bail on their each executing a personal bond and furnishing two <u>reliable and verified</u> sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Magistrate concerned.

If at any point of time, it is found that the applicants are misusing the bail, learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel their bail in accordance with law.
