Applicants – Manveer and Karmveer seek bail in connection with Case Crime No.188 of 2016, under Sections 406, 417, 420, 34 IPC, P.S. Satkarta Adhistan, District Dehradun.

Heard learned counsel for the parties, considered the grounds taken in the bail application and perused the documents on record.

It is the submission of learned counsel for the applicant that applicant is neither the employee of the Mewar University nor he forged any documents and co-accused Gaurav Goyal and Ranzit Gandhi with similar role, have already been granted short term bail for three months by this Court, vide order dated 19.10.2016 and 10.11.2016 respectively.

In the aforesaid circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant only short term bail to the applicant for a period of three months only, even though such prayer has not been made by learned counsel for the applicant.

Let the applicant be enlarged on short term bail, for a period of three months only, on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned.

However, the applicant will be at liberty to move for extension of his bail on or before the expiry of stipulated period of his short term bail.

Bail application stands disposed of accordingly.
