Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

After taking into consideration the facts and
circumstances of the case as well as the conviction and
sentence awarded to the accused petitioner and the fact
that he was on bail during trial as also in appeal, I deem
it just and proper to suspend the sentence awarded to
the petitioner, during the pendency of the revision
petition.

Accordingly, the application for suspension of sentence is allowed and it is ordered that the sentence awarded to accused-petitioner Madanlal Sharma S/o of Shri. Amar Chand Sharma, in Cr. Case No.469/2012 passed by learned trial court for the offences under Section 138 N.I Act shall remain suspended; provided 50% of the fine imposed by Lower Court (after setting of already deposited) will be deposited to be disbursed to the respondent subject to outcome of this revision and further provided that he furnishes a personal bond of Rs. 25,000/- and one surety bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial court to the effect that he shall appear before this Court on 25.11.2016 and, as and when called upon to do so.
