BY THE COURT:

The petitioner has approached this Court against order dated 06.02.2013 passed by District Supply Officer, Jaipur whereby Chief Divisional Retail Sales Manager of Indian Oil Corporation, Jaipur has been required to close down or shift Auto LPG distribution unit from its coco owned retail outlet on Sahkar Marg, Jaipur till the objections raised by

internal security committee are met.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that all the objections have been met and necessary precautionary steps have been taken, even then, the respondents are not passing final order. Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the court towards letter dated 19.04.2016 send by Deputy General Manager(LPG), Indian Oil Corporation Limited to District Magistrate, Jaipur whereby all the objections, precautions/safety measures taken by the petitioner, as advised by the aforesaid committee, have been conveyed with request that permission may be granted to restart auto LPG sales from the said retail outlet.

If that be so, the petitioner is required to approach District Supply Officer, Jaipur or District Collector, Jaipur giving details of such steps, which the petitioner has taken in conformity with the objections raised by the internal security committee, who shall pass appropriate order within a period of two months from the date of approaching of the petitioner.

With the aforesaid direction, writ petition is disposed off. Stay application stands disposed off.
