This bail application has been filed under  
Section 439 Cr.P.C.

Brief facts of the case are that the  
complainant lodged an FIR No. 76/2000 at P.S.  
Manohar Thana.

Learned counsel for the accused petitioners  
has submitted that the accused petitioners were on  
bail and on the date fixed before the learned  
court below, they could not appear as they went  
outside to earn the livelihood as a result of  
which their bail bonds were cancelled. Counsel has  
submitted that the accused petitioners are ready  
to deposit the amount of fine, which this Court  
deems just and proper, hence the accused  
petitioner/s be released on bail.

Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail  
application.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the  
case, but without expressing any opinion on the  
merits and demerits of the case, I deem it just  
and proper to release the petitioner/s on bail.

Therefore, this bail application is allowed  
and it is directed that accused petitioner/s  
(1) Nanu Ram s/o Shri Laxman Singh and (2)  
Sanwarma s/o Ram Chandra shall be released on  
bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in connection with  
the aforesaid FIR, provided he/she/they furnish/es  
a personal bond in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/-

(Rupees two lacs) together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lac) each to the satisfaction of the trial court with the stipulation that he/she/they shall appear before that court on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so. At the time of execution of bail bonds, from the side of accused petitioners, Rs. 12,000/- shall be deposited as fine before the trial court and thereafter, the accused petitioners shall be released on bail.
