By way of the present writ petition it is submitted that petitioner has completed his probation period on the post of Teacher Gr.III and is seeking the benefit of seniority as well as notional fixation of his pay. It is submitted that the representation has already been moved in this regard, which is annexed as Annexure-2 with the writ petition.

A perusal of the said representation does not disclose as to which date, it was served upon the Department.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he will file fresh representation and the same should be considered expeditiously.

In view of the above, I propose to dispose of the writ petition by giving liberty to the petitioner to file fresh representation before the authorities concerned along with certified copy of this order within a period of one week. On receipt of the same, the respondents are directed to dispose of

the representation by passing a speaking order preferably within period of two months thereafter. In case, petitioner is entitled for release of any benefit, the same shall be given to him within a period of one month thereafter.

Needless to say, that if any grievance still survives, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach appropriate court of law.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.
