learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 482 of 2016, registered under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of torturing the complainantopposite party no. 2 by her husband and in-laws due to nonfulfillment of demand of dowry and also to remove to her matrimonial house along with children.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on the

joint payer of learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the complainant-opposite party no.2, the matter was referred before the Mediation Centre, Patna High Court, for settlement of dispute, but the mediation could not be succeeded. It is further submitted that complainant-opposite party no. 2 does not want to go to her matrimonial house making false allegation about re-marring the petitioner with another lady.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-VI, Gopalganj, in connection with Complaint Case No. 482 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
