Heard both sides.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in Bypass P.S. Case No. 133 of 2017 registered for the offences punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 7 of the E.C. Act.

The marketing officer seized two vehicles i.e. one pick up van and a tractor bearing Registration No. BR01GC0193 and BR01GF1041 and alleged that Prem Sagar Prasad illegally loading the foodgrains on both the vehicles for black marketing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are owner and of the pick up van and tractor respectively. They have no manner of concern with loaded

foodgrains. Prem Sagar Prasad hired the vehicles for transportation of the foodgrains.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioners above named in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna in Bypass P.S. Case No. 133 of 2017, Subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
