Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Arwal (Mahila) P.S. Case No. 07 of 2017 registered under Sections 376/457 of the Indian Penal Code pending in the Court of C.J.M., Arwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He has falsely been implicated in this case on account of land dispute and personal grudge. Both the parties are common ancestors.

Learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there is specific allegation against the petitioner. During the course of investigation, the
