G.A. for the respondent-petitioners as well as Ms. P. Sen, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-respondent.</p> <p>This is a petition for extension of time for implementing the judgment and order dated 02.08.2017 delivered in W.P.(C) No.151 of 2014.</p> <p>Mr. Dutta, learned counsel has clearly stated that the government has already decided to implement the said judgment and order but for certain administrative difficulties, the judgment and order could be implemented within the prescribed time and the matter is now lying with the Finance Department for their formal accord.
