Heard Mr. A.Chetia, learned counsel for the accused petitioner and Mr. B.Sarma, learned Addl. P.P. Assam.

By filing this application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the accused/ petitioner Mo zidul Ali @ Dhola apprehending arrest in connection with Gauripur P.S.Case No.90 5/17 U/S 366 (A)/511/34 IPC is praying for anticipatory bail.

Perused the records, documents and the case diary.

So far the allegation is concerned, it transpires that in the college premises the accused simply caught hold of the victim girl for having earlier acquaintance (may be he intended to offer love) and in the process she made hue and cry and the accused petitioner fled away.

Considering the nature of accusation this Court is of the view that custodial interrogation of the accused petitioner is not warranted. Accordingly, accused petitioner in the event of his arrest, in connection with the aforesaid police case, is allowed to go on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with a surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

Anticipatory bail application is disposed of.
