By filing this anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the accu sed petitioner Chandra Mohan Barman apprehending arrest in connection with Golak ganj P.S.Case No.982/17 U/S 342 IPC (GR No.4305/2017) is praying for anticipato ry bail.

Perused the records and the case diary as well as the statement of the victim recorded U/S 164 CrPC who has implicated the accused petitioner.

As per allegation the accused petitioner took the minor girl of the informant a ged about 14 years during the Laxmi Puja and then he tried to forcibly rape her but at the intervention of the local people, who witnessed the occurrence, the a ccused petitioner was apprehended at the spot. Several witnesses have been examined so far and all of them supported the contention that has been raised in the FIR.

Considering the nature of accusation and the complicity of the accused petitione r thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner and accordingly bail prayer of the accused petitioner stands rejected.
