This is an application filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of applicant- Saidul Ali.

The applicant is apprehending his arrest for offences under Sections 454 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Rangia vide Case No.340/17.

According to the prosecution case, one Mousumi Begum lodged a report alleging that some unknown persons broke open the lock of the door of her house and looted household items, including gold ear rings, cash of Rs.50,000/-, bank passbooks and ATMs. The name of the applicant is not mentioned in the first information report. No one has also seen the applicant at and around the place.

It is argued on behalf of the applicant that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated.

On due consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it proper to grant anticipatory bail to applicant. It is, accordingly, directed that in the event of his arrest in connection with the aforesaid case, he be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

The anticipatory bail application is allowed.
