Challenge made in this writ petition is to the settlement order dated 25.06.2015 issued by Mising Autonomous Council in favour of respondent No.4 allowing him to operate the parghat in terms of the NIT dated 11.06.2015. As per the NIT dated 11.06.2015, the settlement was for the period 01.07.2015 to 30.06.2016.

It is quite evident that the said settlement has already expired.

That being the position, Court is of the view that writ petition has become infructuous and is accordingly closed as infructuous.
