With consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the matter is heard finally. In this petition, petitioners inter alia seek a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the partition proceedings pending before him under Section 105 of the J&K Land Revenue Act and Rules in a time bound manner.

When the matter was taken up today, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that respondent No.4 be directed to conclude the proceedings which are pending before him under Section 105 of the Land Revenue Act in a time bound manner after affording an opportunity to all the parties.

On the other hand, learned GA submits that suitable action in accordance with law shall be taken.

In view of the submissions made and facts of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent no.4, namely, Tehsildar, Samba to conclude the proceedings pending before him by a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order passed today. Till the matter pertaining to partition is decided, the amount of compensation shall

not be disbursed in favour of the parties. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on merits of the case of the petitioners.

With the aforesaid direction, the writ petition is disposed of along with connected MP.
