With consent of the learned counsel for the petitioners, the matter is heard finally. In this petition, the petitioners inter alia seek a direction to the respondents to complete the construction of Link Road from 5 kms of Gandoh Jai road upto Luddu Kansar in accordance with the survey and approved alignment.

When the matter was taken up today, learned senior counsel for the petitioners submitted that this writ petition be disposed of with the direction to respondent No.5 namely Executive Engineer, PW(R&B), Special Sub Division Gandoh, Doda and respondent No.6, Executive Engineer, PMGSY, Division Thathri, District Doda to ensure that the road is constructed in accordance with the survey and approved alignment.

On the other hand, learned Sr. AAG submits that road in question shall be constructed in accordance with the survey and approved alignment.

In view of the submissions made and facts of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents 5 and 6 to ensure that the construction of the road be undertaken strictly in accordance with the survey and

approved alignment. Needless to state that if the respondents are aggrieved, they are at liberty to seek revival of this petition.

With the aforesaid liberty, the writ petition is disposed of along with connected MP.
