1. Bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely Nandu Purty @ Pagla Purty who is in custody in connection with R.I.T. PS. Case No. 03 of 2016, corresponding to G.R.Case no. 164 of 2016 (S.T. No. 55 of 2016) for the offence registered U/Ss. 341/324/326/307 IPC.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the State.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the same ground which he had taken on last occasion. He has further submitted that injuries are basically simple in nature. He has also submitted that charge has been framed and witnesses have been summoned for their examination and also the petitioner has been in custody since 29.2.2016 hence, he may be released on bail.
4. Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.
5. Having heard counsel for both sides and looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the above named petitioner on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/-(Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Saraikella in connection with R.I.T. PS. Case No. 03 of 2016, corresponding to G.R.Case no. 164 of 2016 (S.T. No. 55 of 2016) with condition that petitioner will attend each and every date during trial unless it is dispensed of by the learned trial court.
