4/31.07.2017 Apprehending their arrest, the petitioners have moved this Court for grant of privilege of anticipatory bail in connection with Chandrapura P.S. Case No. 50 of 2013 (G.R. No. 551 of 2013) registered under Sections 467,468,469,471, 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegation against the petitioners is that they along with other accused persons indulge themselves in preparing the forged documents of CCL. It is submitted that the petitioners are the owners of the trucks bearing Registration No. JH 02-W-6621 and JH 02-T-8380. The petitioners were made accused in this case as the registration numbers of their trucks were mentioned in the Challan, which were seized from the office of one Dhiraj Kumar. The petitioners' trucks were never involved in the alleged offence. It is further submitted that co-accused- Noor Jahan and Rajesh Jaiswal, with similar allegation, have already been given the privilege of anticipatory bail by this Court in A.B.A. Nos. 2875 & 3222 of 2015 on 8.12.2015 and 10.2.2016 respectively and, therefore, the petitioners be also given the same privilege.

However, learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsel and the fact as discussed above, I am of the opinion that this is a fit case where the petitioners, named above, be admitted to anticipatory bail. Hence, in the event of their arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from the date of this order, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M., 1st Class, Bermo at Tenughat in connection with Chandrapura P.S. Case No. 50 of 2013 (G.R. No. 551 of 2013), subject to the conditions laid down under section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
