The petitioner is an accused in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 8 of 2017.

It appears that the allegation against the petitioner is of enticing away the daughter of the informant. It appears from the statement recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C., victim has stated that she has solemnised marriage with the petitioner.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he is in custody since 05.06.2017.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Regard being had to the statement of victim under Section 164 of Cr.P.C., the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Palamau at Daltonganj in connection with Pipra P. S. Case No. 8 of 2017 corresponding to G. R. No. 318 of 2017.
