Heard Mr. A. K. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. appearing for the State.

This application is directed against the order dated 30.06.2015 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Seraikella in G.R. Case No. 155 of 2015 (Adityapur P.S. Case No. 71 of 2015), whereby and whereunder, the discharge application preferred by the petitioner u/s 239 Cr.P.C., has been rejected..

It appears that the petitioner is the husband of the informant who is alleged to have committed torture upon the informant and has tried to burn her.

From perusal of the order dated 30.06.2015 it appears that several witnesses have supported the factum of cruelty. It appears that sufficient evidence has been collected against the petitioner in course of investigation, which has properly been appreciated in the impugned order. There being no reason to conclude otherwise and in such circumstances, I am not inclined to interfere with the order dated 30.06.2015 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Seraikella in G.R. Case No. 155 of 2015 (Adityapur P.S. Case No. 71 of 2015).

Accordingly, having found no merit in this application, the same is hereby dismissed.
