The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bermo P.S. Case No. 135/2016 corresponding to G.R. No. 914/2016, the case registered under Sections 143,147,149 and 353 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence as alleged in the FIR. It is further submitted that they have been falsely implicated in the present case.

Learned A.P.P opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the fact and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within four weeks from the date of this order and in the event of their arrest or surrender, the Court below shall enlarge the above named petitioners, on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.,Bermo at Tenughat, in connection with Bermo P.S. Case No. 135/2016 corresponding to G.R. No. 914/2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
