Heard Miss. S.Das, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.A.K.Mishra, learn ed counsel appearing for opposite party-Railway.

Petitioner in this writ petition assails the order dated 18.12.2017 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack in M.A. No. 260/655/2017 arising o ut of O.A. No. 260/714/2017 wherein the Tribunal rejected the prayer for restraining the reversion and observed that the legality of the reversion order shall be subject to the final outcome of the original application.

It is submitted at the Bar that the Apex Court by order dated 15.12.2017 in Sp ecial Leave to Appeal (C) No. 22444 of 2017 has opined that for the time being the regular pro motions made prior to 12.7.2016 should not be affected.

In view of such, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order pass ed by the Tribunal. It is open to the parties to argue the matter before the Tribunal on merit of the original application.

Accordingly the writ petition is disposed of.
