

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State, Vigilance.

The petitioner is an accused in G.R. case No.359(A) of 2015 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Banki registered under Sections 341/294/324/506/307/120-B/34, I.P.C and Section 4 and 5 of the E.S.Act.

It is alleged that some persons threw bomb at the informant causing injury to him and to his grand son. It is further alleged that the present petitioner arranged the entire occurrence and had engaged some accused persons on hiring to commit murder of the victim, but fortunately he escaped.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that merely basing on confessional statement allegedly given by the petitioner before the Police he has been implicated falsely.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has some criminal antecedents and he was the mastermind behind the entire occurrence.

The charge-sheet has already been submitted and the petitioner is in custody since 15.03.2017.

Considering the submissions, it is directed that let the petitioner be released on bail by furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Banki in the aforesaid case with the conditions that he shall not involve himself in any criminal activities and shall not default in personal attendance of court during trial on each date.

The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
