03. 30.11.2017 Heard Mr. Nayak, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Sa mantaray, learned Standing Counsel for the State.

In this writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for a writ of mandamus directing the opposite parties to adjust the consideration money deposited (for ten days extra), within the accounting period of 2017-18 and to take appropriate consequential action.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the bac kground of Rule 151 of the Excise Rules, 2015 opportunity may be granted to the petitioner to move the Collector & District Magistrate, Cuttack (O.P. No.2) in the matter and prays that a direction be issued to O.P. No.2 to dispose of such motion within a specific time period.

Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion in the matter, liber ty is granted to the petitioner to move the Collector & District Magistrate, Cuttack (O.P. No. 2) in the above noted matter within a period of ten days along with certified copy of this or der. In the event such a representation is moved before O.P. No.2, the Collector & District M agistrate, Cuttack (O.P. No.2) would do well to dispose of the same in accordance with law by passing a reasoned order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

The writ application is accordingly disposed of.
