

19. 27.4.2017 Learned counsel for the opposite parties-Bank files in the Court today the copy of the order passed by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Odisha, dated 03.3.2017, which is taken on record.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the opposite parties-Bank.

This writ petition has been filed challenging the order dated 12.11.2014, passed by the opposite parties-Bank, rejecting the application of the petitioners for one time settlement.

Learned counsel for the opposite parties-Bank submits that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 25.11.2016, the matter was placed before the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Odisha, who vide his order dated 03.3.2017 has considered the application of the petitioners for one time settlement and has rejected the same, as the same does not come within the prescribed guidelines.

In view of such submissions made by learned counsel for the opposite parties-Bank and the order of the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Odisha, dated 03.3.2017, no further cause of action survives.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous.

It is open for the petitioners to assail the order of the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Odisha, dated 03.3.2017, if so advised.
