Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for anticipatory bail who allegedly involved under sections 143/341/342/ 353/294/506/149 I.P.C.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the allegation against the petitioners is false and fabricated and due to previous enmity the case has been filed. So he submits to release the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any condition as deemed just and proper.

Considering the submissions of learned counsel for both sides, regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, materials on record, nature of allegation and having no chance of fleeing from justice this Court directs that in the event of arrest each of the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) with two solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer in connection with G.R. Case No. 456 of 2017 corresponding to Kutra P.S. Case No.74 of 2017 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Rajgangpur on conditions that (i) they shall appear before the I.O. as and when required for the purpose of investigation; and (ii) they shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence directly or indirectly.

Violation of any of the aforesaid conditions shall entail cancellation of the anticipatory bail.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
