This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for anticipat
ory bail for the offence under Sections 294/323/506/34 of IPC.

Considering the submissions of learned counsel for both sides, regard being ha
d to the facts and circumstances of the case and the material on record, this Court directs th
at in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail of Rs.50,000/
- (rupees fifty thousand) with two solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfacti
on of the Arresting Officer in connection with G.R. Case No.267 of 2012 corresponding to Ranpu
r P.S. Case No.264 of 2012 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Ranpur on conditions that

(i) The petitioner shall appear before the I.O. as and when required for the purpose of inves
tigation; and (ii) he shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence directly or indirectly.

Violation of any of the aforesaid conditions shall entail cancellation of the antic
ipatory bail.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
