The petitioner having been implicated in Kharvelnagar P.S. Case No.88 of 2015 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1014 of 2015 registered for alleged commission of offence under sections 420/467/468/471/34, I.P.C. pending in the Court of the learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar has filed this application for grant of bail in the event of his arrest in the said case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petitioner who is now prosecuting his study at Ravenshaw University in Bachelor in Business Administration course has been made an accused in the case on the allegation that the principal accused Sambit Mohanty creating the forged documents in the name of this petitioner had obtained the agency contract from the ING Life Insurance. He further submits that this petitioner having come to know about it had himself written for termination of the contract said to have been made in his name and accordingly it has been so terminated in the year 2012. Therefore, he urges for grant of anticipatory bail to this petitioner when there remains least scope on his part to flee from justice or tamper the evidence.

Learned Additional Government Advocate does not dispute that the agency in the name of this petitioner stands terminated since March, 2012. It is also submitted by him that the petitioner has cooperated with the investigation and his statement has thus been recorded by the I.O.

Considering the submissions, in view of the nature of accusations and other surrounding circumstances of the case, in the absence of any other impediment, it is directed that in the event of the petitioner surrenders before the court below in the above mentioned case, he be released on bail with such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the court in seisin of the case with further condition that he will appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
