The petitioner before this court has filed this present contempt petition alleging non-compliance of the order dated 25-06-2015 passed in Writ Petition No. 120/2014.

In the aforesaid case, this court has directed the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and to pass an appropriate order in light of the judgment delivered in the case of Kailash Chandra Vs. State of M.P. and others in Writ Appeal No. 359/2010.

Ms Chitralekha appearing for the contemnor has drawn the attention of this court towards the order dated 09-03-2017 passed in Contempt petition No. 6464/2015 and her contention is that this court after taking into account the judgment delivered in the case of Kailash Chandra has dismissed the contempt petition.

In light of the aforesaid, this court is of the considered opinion that once the respondents have passed a speaking order, no further order is required to pass in the present contempt petition. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file a fresh writ petition, in case he so desires.

Let copy of the order passed in Contempt Petition No. 6464/2015 be kept in the file of the present case also.

With the aforesaid, the contempt petition stands disposed off.
