Verification report as directed vide order dated 03.01.2017 is not received yet.

The petitioner has challenged in this petition registration of FIR No.321/11 by Police Station Neelganga, Ujjain lodged against him under Section 120-B, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC.

The grievance of the petitioner is that he has a valid registration and therefore no offence can be constituted against him, but the police is not investigating the case properly and not considering his documents relating to his registration under the Pharmacy Act.

Considering the aforesaid, the Police Station Neelganga, Ujjain is directed to accept the documents being produced by the petitioner and consider the same during investigation and after considering all the documents, formed its opinion and proceed further.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for a liberty to approach this Court again, if occasion so arise.

Prayer is allowed.

With the aforesaid direction to the police and the liberty to the petitioner, the present petition is **dismissed** as withdrawn.
