This is the **first** application filed by the applicant under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail.

The applicant is apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No.09/2017 registered at P.S. Meghnagar, District Jhabua for offences punishable under Section 34(2) and 36 M.P. Excise Act.

After arguing the matter for sometime, learned counsel for the applicant does not wish to press this application and seeks liberty to the applicant to surrender before the trial Court and the Court may be directed to consider his bail application on the same day.

Prayer is not opposed by the other side.

Considering the aforesaid, the bail application stands **dismissed as not pressed** with a liberty to the applicant to surrender before the trial Court and apply for regular bail, which shall be decided as expeditiously as possible.
