This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to the respondents to grant notional promotion on the post of Upper Division Teacher w.e.f. 1/7/1972. The petitioner is claiming the said benefit in terms of the order of this Court in the matter of Sultan Khan Qureshi Vs. State of M.P. and others passed in W.P.No.6176/2003 decided on 21.9.2007.

When the matter is taken up today, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a direction be issued to the respondents to consider the petitioner's case in the light of the judgment in the matter of Sultan Khan (supra).

Counsel for the State has fairly stated that if the petitioner files a representation enclosing therewith a copy of the judgment in the matter of Sultan Khan (supra), then the petitioner's case will be considered in the light of the said judgment in accordance with law, within a time bound period.

In these circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of by permitting the petitioner to file an appropriate representation enclosing therewith all the material on which the petitioner wants to place reliance upon. If such a representation is filed by the petitioner, the competent authority will decide the same in the light of the material enclosed therewith within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case if the petitioner is found entitled, the necessary benefit be extended to him without any delay.
