Heard.

The petitioner before this Court was working as a Class IV employee at Govt. Girls Middle School, Manikpur, Block Shahpura, Distt. Dindori. He is aggrieved by the inaction on the part of respondents to decide his representation dated 10.07.2017 (Annexure P/7) which has been filed by the petitioner on account of the fact that he was earlier appointed on a vacant post on 19.10.2015 as daily wages basis and has continuously worked since then but recently the Principal/respondent no.3 has restrained the petitioner from carrying out his duties. Being aggrieved by the same, the aforesaid representation was submitted by the petitioner before the Assistant Commissioner/respondent no.2.

Since the petitionerâ s representation is still pending, in the circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Assistant Commissioner/respondent no.2 to decide the petitionerâ s representation dated 10.07.2017 (Annexure P/7) in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The petitioner is allowed to submits further documents to

substantiate his case.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any view on the merits of the case.

Accordingly, the petition stands *disposed of*. C.C. as per rules.
