The learned counsel appearing for the Applicant on instructions states that in view of the subsequent payment made by the Respondent, the prayers (a) and (b) will not survive. The other issue was regarding the expenditure on medical treatment of the daughters. The parties have agreed that Applicant can take New India Floater Mediclaim Policy in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/- for which total yearly premium payable is 14,352/-.

The learned counsel appearing for the Respondent on

instructions stated that the Respondent will pay a sum of Rs. 3,500/- to the Applicant on or before 31st January of every calender year till the disposal of the appeal. The Respondent will pay a sum of Rs.3,500/- on or before 31 January of every year to the Applicant to enable the Applicant to pay the yearly premium of the said policy. We accept the said statements. The learned counsel appearing for the Applicant states that the Applicant is willing to accept this suggestion. Order accordingly. We direct that for the current year, the amount of Rs.3,500/- shall be paid by the Respondent to the Applicant within a period of two weeks from today. Subject to what is stated above, the application is disposed of.
