This writ petition is filed seeking to declare the action of the respondents in not extending the benefit of retrospective regularization from the date of appointment and not extending the minimum time scale to the petitioner on par with the petitioners in W.P.No. 19277 of 1999 as illegal and arbitrary and consequently direct the respondents to extend the benefit to the petitioner as was given to the petitioners in the above said writ petition.

- 2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Higher Education.
- 3. Learned Government Pleader fairly agrees that the subject matter in this writ petition is squarely covered by order dated 05-10-2000 in W.P.No. 9945 of 2010, by virtue of which the Court disposed of the writ petition directing the respondents therein to consider the case of the petitioner on par with those covered by G.O.Ms.No. 230 dated 25-09-2008 and extend the benefit of regularization of service in respondent No 1-college with effect from the date of his appointment, being subsequent to the granting of aid to respondent No. 1-college.

4. Hence, in terms of the said order, there shall be a direction to

the respondents in this case to consider the case of the petitioner on

par with those covered by G.O.Ms.No. 230 dated 25-09-2008 and

extend the benefit of regularization of his service in respondent No.

4-college with effect from the date of his appointment, being

subsequent to the granting of aid to respondent No. 4-college. This

exercise shall be completed within three months from the date of

receipt of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. Pending

miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in

consequence.
