This W.P. coming on for Preliminary Hearing in 'B' group this day, the Court made the following:-

ORDER

The plea of the petitioner is for consideration of his application dated 15.06.1995 vide Annexure-A. Since there has been a long lapse of time, it is just and appropriate to direct the respondent No.3 to consider the same in accordance with law.

2. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed off. The respondent No. 3 is directed to consider the representation dated 15.06.1995 vide Annexure-A and pass appropriate orders therein in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible provided the same is within time, authentic and contains all the relevant documents.

3. Petitioner shall not be dispossessed from the land in question, if not already dispossessed till such application is considered and disposed off by the respondent No. 3.
