Leaving the questions of law open, a direction is issued to the competent authority to consider and decide the petitioner's representation alongwith Annexures P1 to P3 of the present writ petition, in accordance with law, by affording due opportunity of hearing/representation to the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of production of certified copy of this order. Needless to add, if the order is not in favour of the petitioner, the authority shall assign reasons while deciding the same, which shall be communicated to the petitioner. Liberty reserved to the petitioner to place additional material on record, if any.
- 5. With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands disposed of, so also pending applications, if any.
