Petitioner approached this Court with the following  
prayers:

“i. That an appropriate writ order or directions may  
very kindly be issued directing the respondents to  
grant the approval for running the Bachelor of  
Physiotherapy Programme in the petitioner  
University and further not to insist for  
NOC/Essentiality Certificate and approval every  
year which is otherwise contrary to the law in the  
interest of law and justice.”

2. Though, initially the respondents defended the petition, but pursuant to various orders passed by this Court, petitioner's institute was inspected and with the removal of shortcomings, now the competent authority after inspection has accorded no objection in allowing the petitioner's institute to impart education to students in a particular course.

3. As such, we direct the respondent authorities to allow the petitioner's institute to run the course of Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) for academic session 2017-18. Needful be positively done within a period of one week from today.

In view of the above, present petition stands disposed of alongwith pending applications, if any.
