The petitioner is directed to appear before the learned Divisional Commissioner, Mandi 08.08.2017, on which date, petitioner shall put in appearance and obtain dasti notices to be served upon the respondents.

3. In the meantime, the operation of the impugned order (Annexure P-1), dated 22.4.2017, passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Kullu, H.P., shall remain stayed.

Accordingly, in view of above, the present petition is disposed of alongwith pending application(s), if any.
