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By way of this application, the applicant/appellant has prayed for condonation of one day's delay in filing the appeal.

Mr. Vikram Thakur, learned Deputy Advocate General accepts notice on behalf of non-applicants/respondents No. 2 and 3. He submits that he has no objection in case the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant and learned Deputy Advocate General. I have also gone through the averments made in the application. A perusal of the averments made in the application demonstrate that the delay in filing the appeal is bonafide and not intentional and the same has resulted on account of some error of calculation in the computation of limitation.
