<u>JUDGMENT</u>

The petitioner is aggrieved with the revenue recovery proceedings initiated against the petitioner's property.

- 2. The learned Counsel for the first respondent Bank appears and submits that the total outstanding dues comes to Rs.46,88,470/-. There is no question of regularisation since the unit itself has become closed.
- 3. The liability and the default are admitted. Considering the facts of the case and the alleged impecunious circumstances of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed of on the following terms:
- (i) The total outstanding dues is said to be Rs.46,88,470/- as on 31.05.2017.
- (ii) The 2nd respondent shall grant fifteen monthly instalments for the payment of the entire outstanding dues

starting from 12.11.2017 and continued on the 12th of the

successive months. Accrued interest due and the collection

charges at the rate of 1% would be payable as the 13th

instalment, for which a demand shall be made. The collection

charges on payment shall be made over to the revenue recovery

authorities.

(iii) Recovery proceedings shall be kept in abeyance on

condition that the remittances as per this order are made without

any default.

(iv) On the petitioner making two defaults in repaying the

installments, the recovery steps initiated shall revive and

continue.

(v) On the petitioner satisfying the entire arrears, the

recovery proceedings shall be unenforceable.
