This petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking suspension of his sentence of imprisonment.

2. The petitioner/A2 faced trial in Spl.C. No.7 of 2012 on the file of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Special Judge, Ariyalur and the trial Court, by a judgment dated 30.05.2017, convicted and sentenced the petitioner as under:

7 of Prevention of Corruption Act	five years rigorous imprisonment and to pay a fine of Rs.16000/- in default to undergo simple imprisonment for one year
Sec 13(2) r/w.13(1) (d) of Prevention of Corruption Act	Seven years rigorous imprisonment and to pay a fine of Rs.16000/- in default to undergo simple imprisonment for one year
	The sentences are to run concurrently.

until further orders.
