ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

Simranjeet Kaur and Jagdeep Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 11 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 to 11. A true photocopy of the marriage certificate dated 27.06.2017 has been placed on record. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 27.06.2017, Annexure P-4 to respondent No.2.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-4, within a period of one month and grant them

protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
