Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.188 dated 12.10.2015 registered under Sections 279, 337 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Mattaur, District SAS Nagar, on the basis of compromise Annexure-P3.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 06.09.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial

their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter bearing No.482 dated 18.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar vide Endst. No.9555 dated 18.09.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar (Mohali), the compromise between the parties is voluntary, genuine and without any pressure or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.188, is quashed qua the petitioner only.
