Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has submitted a representation dated 06.09.2017 regarding him having been defrauded of Rs.10,00,000/- approximately by one Rakesh Kumar, S/o Kaka Ram and receipt of threats from the said person to withdraw complaint dated 05.09.2017. It is also stated in the said representation that these persons have made him sign blank papers.

Notice of motion. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Abhaypal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of State. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the nature of allegations made and without commenting upon the merits of the case, it is deemed appropriate to dispose of the petition with direction to respondent No.3 to enquire into the representation (Annexure P-1), dated 06.09.2017 and take appropriate

action, in accordance with law, in case, any cognizable offence is made out after the enquiry.
