Since the Bar Association is abstaining from work, neither counsel for the petitioners nor counsel for the State is present. Head Constable Paramjit Singh from Police Station Sadar, Rajpura, is present and has stated that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on 30.03.2017, i.e. yesterday.

In such a situation, obviously the order of this Court that in case he does not surrender, his bail and surety bonds would be forfeited, would not be operative.

It is to be noticed here that upon the petitioner not having appeared constantly before the trial Court, non-bailable warrants for his arrest were issued on 03.01.2017, as can be seen from paragraph 5 of the petition. Despite that, this Court had admitted him to bail from 18.03.2017 to 26.03.2017 as he was to be married on 19.03.2017, which fact was got confirmed by the learned State counsel.

That period being over and the petitioner having over stayed even his interim bail from 26.03.2017 to 29.03.2017, any bail application made by him before the trial Court would be dealt with on its own merits.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
