The petitioners are wife and son of late Paramjit Singh whose land fully described in para No.2 of the writ petition, situated within the revenue estate of Tung Bala Urban, Amritsar, was acquired for the purpose of Truck Stand Scheme developed by Improvement Trust, Amritsar. The acquisition was carried out in the year 1974. It is averred that the predecessor-in-interest of the petitioners applied for allotment of a plot on 07.08.1979 in the category of local displaced persons. The said application remained pending for years and it was on 11.06.1996 that the improvement Trust sought permission of the State Government for allotment of a plot to late Paramjit Singh under the local displaced persons category. It is further averred that though all the claims were disposed of on 30.06.2006 but the deceased-predecessor-in-interest of the petitioners was not allotted any plot. Paramjit Singh is said to have expired on 30.01.2016. He was statedly pursuing the matter and served the authorities with a legal notice dated 08.03.2015 (P-7). There is no response to the said legal notice till date.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the averments that the claim submitted by late Paramjit Singh for allotment of a plot is still under consideration and no decision has been taken so far, we dispose of this writ petition without expressing any views on merits with a direction to the Improvement Trust, Amritsar that if the above-stated claim of the petitioners is still pending, let the same be decided by way of a reasoned order within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. It is further directed that if the authorities decide to allot a plot to the petitioners, such allotment shall be made at the current allotment price only.
