Petitioner-association claims that respondent No.2 is an instrumentality of the State and is under the supervision of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. The petitioner had a right to participate in the Sub-Junior Tournament in the month of December in Kerala but having not been invited by respondent No.2, the rights of the petitioner have been defeated.

The claim of the petitioner seems to have been declined by respondent No.2 on the ground that as per their record Baseball Association Chandigarh is affiliated unit of Amateur Baseball Federation of India headed by Mr. Jaspal Singh as President and Mr. Kiran Rampal as General Secretary and the Federation had been sending all communications at the office address i.e. at 923, Sector 7-B, Chandigarh as such they do not recognize the address of the petitioner which is of Burail.

It appears that there is an inter se dispute regarding the representation of Baseball Association, Chandigarh. The rights of the petitioner-association cannot be considered unless until the members of the

Association who have set up an office at 923, Sector 7-B, Chandigarh, are impled as party.

Even otherwise, without expression of any opinion regarding any enforceable right available with the petitioner, I deem it appropriated to dispose of this petition with liberty to the petitioner to settle the inter se dispute amongst the members of the Association and claim its rights qua any other Federation in accordance with law.

Disposed of as pre-mature at this stage.
