**Rajesh Bindal, J.**

The petitioner has approached this Court claiming that acquisition of land of the petitioner has lapsed in view of provisions of Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (for short 'the Act') as the possession thereof has not been taken though the compensation has been received by the petitioner. To establish his possession, the petitioner has placed on record certain photographs Annexure P-6. A bare perusal of the photographs shows that it is new construction, which has recently been painted. Apparently, it has been done to invoke provisions of Section 24(2) of the Act, especially when the compensation had also been received.

For the reasons mentioned above, we do not find any merit in the present petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.
